
1. Disconnect the battery earth lead.

- 3 Remove the resonator box retaining clip.




- 3. Disconnect the traction control motor multiplug.

 - 2 Remove the motor cover.




4. Detach the traction control motor.

- 2 Remove the traction control motor retaining nuts.




5. Disconnect the throttle cable from the throttle quadrant.

- 2 Disconnect the throttle cable from the quadrant.




6. Disconnect the throttle cable from the upper motor pulley.
