




CAUTION: If brake fluid is spilt on the paintwork, the effected area must be immediately washed down with cold water.


- 1. Disconnect the battery earth lead.
- 2. Disconnect the brake pipes from the hydraulic unit.
- Allow the brake fluid to drain into a suitable container.
- Plug the brake pipes to prevent fluid loss and dirt ingress.





- 3. Disconnect the hydraulic unit multiplug.
 - 1 Pull the multiplug retaining clip upwards.
- 2 Disconnect the multiplug.
